



## Learner Voice

To ensure we develop individuals for the future the four purposes are also important as we plan and enjoy our activities and tasks.




















### School Council




In order to realise our vision as a school and the requirements of the Curriculum Framework, excellent teaching is essential.

## Assessment and Progress

We strongly believe that every child deserves the opportunity to make progress in their learning, and this is the main purpose of our assessment procedures in our schools. We gain a full picture of each child's development in their understanding, skills, and knowledge as they progress through the early years of their education. We place emphasis on the importance of collaboration and shared understanding of progress across practitioners in every classroom, and this is developed through regular professional discussions with each other, parents, and carers. In this way, we respond to the Assessment Purposes of the Curriculum...

### Showing Progress

From joining the school until leaving, a sample of each learner's work is collected and kept in a personal file. A sample of writing, speaking, reading, and mathematics work is kept, as well as their well-being and emotional development.

### Continious Support

Ongoing support for our learners is daily. Consistent assessment systems in the classroom provide a clear picture to practitioners and learners of their achievements and what their next steps are. It is important to us that every child takes responsibility for their own progress under guidance and encouragement.


### Reflecting and Refining Progress










# Our Learners' Opinion on our Curriculum
